



GILDO PALLANCA PASTOR

The career of Gildo Pallanca Pastor began when he was 21 years old with the construction of the Gildo Pastor Center, a 90.000 m² office and industry complex, dedicated to the memory of his grandfather Gildo Pastor. This real-estate complex, the biggest office building in Monaco, is a great success and now hosts renowned international companies as well as a number of institutions.

His grandfather was the most important real estate developer in Monaco from 1930 until today. He became the largest private real estate owner in the Principality, owning several thousands of high-standard apartments. His most remarkable realisation is the Princess Grace Avenue, the sea side district of the Principality of Monaco.

Since his grand father died in 1990, Gildo Pallanca – Pastor is managing a part of his family real estate assets and has developed a private equity investment activity. Leader in the “Business Angels” movement in Europe, he militates for enterprise creation subsidies, innovation financing, and environment.

- Co-director of the Monaco Naval Museum,
- Administrator of charitable and humanitarian foundations and associations,
- Automobile pilot from 1986 to 1999 and holder of a world speed record.

Gildo Pallanca Pastor was born April 1st, 1967 in Monaco.

After his baccalaureate in Maths and Physics, he undertook Law and Economics studies in France and Italy while managing his professional activities (he had his first company when he was 19).

He has the Monegasque citizenship and is a permanent resident of the Principality of Monaco.
